

Dr. Sarah Reichard is a Professor at the University of Washington and is Director of its Botanic Garden. Her research is focused on understanding the biology of invasive plants and using that understanding to develop risk assessment methods to prevent their introduction and spread. Dr. Reichard co-authored a National Academy of Science report "Predicting Invasions of Nonindigenous Plants and Plant Pests." Editor of "Invasive Species in the Pacific Northwest," (University of Washington Press) and author of numerous research papers, she also served six years on the federal Invasive Species Advisory Committee and is on the Invasive Species Specialist Group of the International Union for the Conservation of Nature. Her newest book is *The Conscientious Gardener: Cultivating a Garden Ethic* (University of California Press). Dr. Reichard founded and directs the Washington Rare Plant Care and Conservation Program, which works with federal, state, and local agencies to protect Washington's rare plant species.
