GEORGE WAS BORN IN BONNERS FERRY, IDAHO AND RAISED IN DOVER, IDAHO. HE GRADUATED FROM SANDPOINT SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN SANDPOINT, IDAHO. FOLLOWING FOUR YEARS OF U.S. NAVY SERVICE, GEORGE GRADUATED FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA WITH A BS DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION.

AFTER A BRIEF TIME IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR, GEORGE ENTERED FEDERAL SERVICE WITH THE RURAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION IN WASHINGTON D.C. AND THEN LATER TRANSFERRED TO THE BONNEVILLE POWER ADMINISTRATION. DURING HIS BONNEVILLE CAREER GEORGE WAS PRIMARILY INVOLVED IN VARIOUS ASPECTS OF THE ELECTRIC ENERGY MARKETING FUNCTIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

GEORGE RETIRED FROM BONNEVILLE IN 1999, RETURNED TO HIS HOME TOWN OF DOVER AND WAS ELECTED TO THE IDAHO HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN NOVEMBER, 2000.
