He is currently the Vice President of Generation Asset Management and responsible for the power operations interface with the US Army Corps of Engineers, US Bureau of Reclamation, and Energy Northwest. He is also responsible for the stream flow forecasting, hydro generation forecasting, power planning, and scheduling functions. Steve serves as the co-Coordinator for the US Entity for the Columbia River Treaty.

From 1996 through April 2005, Steve served as the Vice President for Bulk Power Marketing and Transmission Services. He was responsible for BPA's surplus power sales, trading floor functions, ancillary services marketing, transmission acquisition, and sales to PNW investor owned utilities and Direct Service Industrial loads.

Prior to joining Bonneville, Steve worked for the California Energy Commission, the Sacramento Municipal Utility District, and the Western Area Power Administration.
