**Idaho State Representative Britt Raybould to Serve as U.S. Vice President of the Pacific NorthWest Economic Region (PNWER)**

*Raybould will serve a multi-year term as vice chair of the bi-national nonprofit organization*

**WHISTLER, BC** – The Pacific NorthWest Economic Region’s (PNWER) Delegate Council elected Britt Raybould, state representative of Idaho’s 34th Legislative District, to serve in the role of PNWER U.S. vice president at the PNWER Annual Summit in Whistler, BC, July 21.

Raybould will represent the state of Idaho during her term on the PNWER board, which includes a president and four vice presidents – two from the U.S. and two from Canada. PNWER’s elected officers serve the organization’s 10 member jurisdictions and work collaboratively to identify solutions to regional challenges.

Raybould was elected to the Idaho House of Representatives in 2018 and was reelected in 2022. She serves on the Joint Finance-Appropriation Committee, Resources & Conservation Committee, and the Environment, Energy & Technology Committee.

“I’m honored to serve and support PNWER’s mission to lead on the policy and economic issues that matter to our states and provinces,” Raybould said. “PNWER brings together an incredible group of individuals dedicated to helping their communities navigate complex challenges by learning from each other and working together. As partners, we can combine our efforts to produce region-wide results that strengthen us individually.”
