

## COVID Testing for Canadian Travelers Information Sheet

The Canadian government currently requires arriving travelers to present a negative COVID test result upon arrival at a port of entry.

- The test must have been administered within 72 hours of the travelers' arrival to the border.
- The test must be an accepted test type (PCR - saliva sample/nasal swab).

### Testing Locations around Bozeman:

Visit the above links to view all options for testing in the Bozeman area. Some testing centers require a provider's order, which can be obtained by calling the COVID hotline (406-414-2619). A provider's order can be obtained up to 30 days in advance of the test. Requesting the order only takes a few minutes via phone. Test results will be received via a mobile app. More information will be available during testing.

### Recommended Testing Locations:

**Big Sky Medical Center Drive-thru (Closest Option to Big Sky Resort)** - 334 Town Center Ave, Big Sky, MT (Open daily from 9AM to 5PM)

- Located about in Big Sky Town Center approx. 10 minutes drive down the mountain from Big Sky Resort.
- Provider order required. Call COVID Hotline to get a provider order.
- Test results likely within 48 hours (Mon. - Thurs.). Up to 72 hours (Fri. - Sun.).

**B2 Urgent Care** - 1006 W Main Street, Bozeman, MT (Open daily from 8 to 7 p.m.)

- Located in downtown Bozeman approx. 1 hr. drive from Big Sky Resort.
- Larger medical clinic.
- Walk-in available. No provider order needed.
- Same day test results likely.

**COVID-19 Testing Prices:**

In accordance with the CARES act, Bozeman Health's charges for COVID-19 testing and specimen collect is as follows through August 31, 2021:


- COVID-19 Test \$175.00
- COVID-19 Antibody Test \$100.00
- COVID-19 Rapid Molecular Test \$250.00
- COVID-19 Vaccine administration--currently no charge.

Other tests and screening may be ordered and provided at the same time of service, which will affect a total bill for this service.

The cost of COVID-19 testing (including antibody testing) will be submitted to your health insurance, which we will verify when we register you. If you do not have health insurance, COVID-19 testing and specimen collection it may be billed to HRSA (Health Resource and Service Administration- funds available under the CAREs act) or State covered testing programs on your behalf.

If you prefer to utilize the pay now option and not use insurance, the cash rate for the COVID-19 test is \$150.00 and the COVID-19 Rapid Molecular Test is \$230.00, which will be collected at the time of service. The pay now cash rate for a COVID-19 antibody test is \$75.00.
